President's Summary



2023 was an exciting year of key growth and development for NOMI. Below are some of our achievements and highlights, and a look into what's coming up in 2024.

Nonprofit Status

NOMI was incorporated as a nonprofit organization in 2022. This year, we were pleased to receive our 501(c)(6) status from the IRS. This important designation allows us to operate as a professional trade board to promote the common

interests of our membership. It also allows NOMI to support legislative lobbying to help further our mission in integrating professional medical intuitives into healthcare. 501(c)(6) membership fees and donations may be deductible to members and donors as a trade or business expense.

Membership

NOMI Membership officially opened in March of 2023. We were thrilled to kickstart the year with **Professional Memberships** leading the way, followed by a growing number of **Student Memberships**.

NOMI created four new **<u>Supporting Membership</u>** levels with robust benefits and opportunities for both individuals and organizations.

NOMI Professional Member Badge was made available. Plans to create a uniquely distinct Supporting Member badge in 2024 are underway.


The NOMI website was updated and expanded:


- Navigation was added to make it easier for visitors to follow steps for applications.
